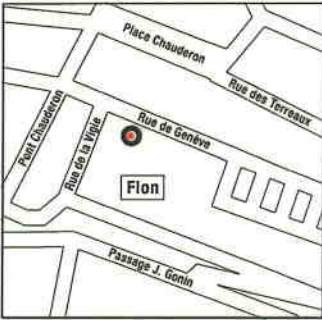

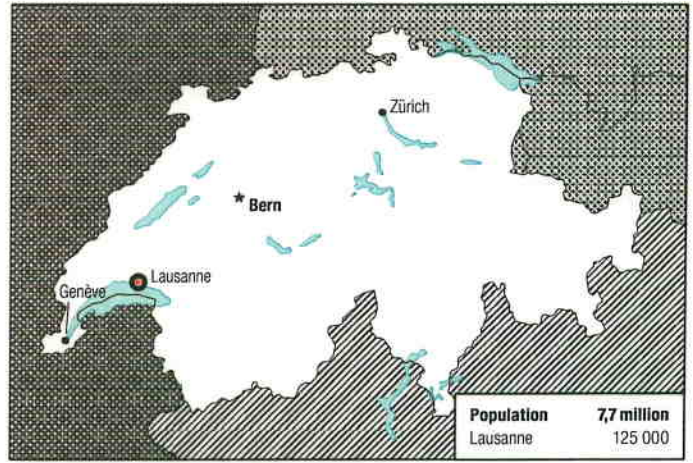


#### Accommodation

## Lausanne
